**Scrip Program (3-10% return) (retail gift card program) (year-round)**

Log on to [www.shopwithscrip.com](http://www.shopwithscrip.com). Complete the registration. Use the RVMB Enrollment Code : C66D9CC815631. Once you've registered you can start shopping and submit the order from your home, office, etc. All RVMB member orders will be submitted together each Sunday evening after 10 PM and are available for pick up on Wednesday evenings or at another arranged time. Bring your payment (made payable to RVMB) with you when you pick up your cards. **E-Books\* (60% return) (late Aug. thru Oct.)**

The booster organization earns \$6 for every \$10 book sold. Your student is credited with \$3 and the general fund is credited with \$3 per book sold. Checks are made payable to RVMB. Be sure to note the student's name in the memo section of the check to ensure proper credit. Books will be made available in class. All unsold books must be returned or paid for.



**Taste of Colorado (soda booth) (100% return) (Labor Day weekend)**

Shifts are available for students and family members to staff a soda booth during this 3 day event, which earns approximately \$6.75 an hour per worker. Your student is credited the full amount. **Butter Braids\* (40% return) (November for Holidays; March for Easter)**

The booster organization earns \$4 for each \$10 butter braid sold. Your student is credited with \$2 and the general fund is credited for \$2 for each braid sold. Checks are made payable to RVMB. Be sure to note the student's name in the memo section of the checks collected to ensure proper credit. Order forms will be made available in class.



**School Function Snack Bars (various returns)**

The booster organization runs snack bars at several functions that are held at Ralston Valley including; Music in the Parks, The Middle School Band/Orchestra Festival, The Mile High Jazz Festival, Spring Musical. Proceeds benefit the general fund.



**Barnes & Noble Denver West (10% return) (December 4, 2010 in store; Dec. 3-5 online sales)**

The booster organization earns 10% on all sales when purchaser uses coupon vouchers found in-store or online supporting RV Music Boosters. Your student is credited with \$3.20 and the general fund is credited the remainder for each meal ticket sold. Checks are made payable to RVMB. ### Monthly Restaurant Nights (various returns)

The booster organization will arrange monthly restaurant nights at various locations that will

offer our organization a percentage of sales for that evening. Proceeds benefit the general fund.



### Music In The Parks (100% return)

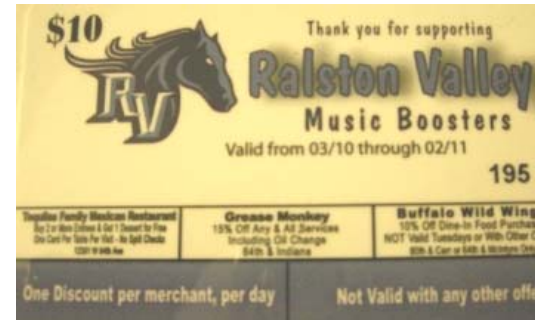
